6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to firearms; allowing certain persons
8 the right to bypass security checkpoints in the State
9 Capitol; providing for codification; and providing an
10 effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1290.28 of Title 21, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Any person in possession of a valid handgun license issued
16 pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, when
17 entering the State Capitol building through a security checkpoint
18 attended by a commissioned peace officer, shall be authorized to
19 bypass the security checkpoint upon presentation of the valid
20 handgun license and valid state issued identification. Nothing in
21 this section shall be construed to authorize a law enforcement
22 officer to remove or inspect any weapon or restrain any person
23 carrying a properly concealed loaded or unloaded handgun without
24 probable cause that a crime has been committed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
