18	Section 26. A. The <u>fundamental</u> right of <u>each</u> individual a
L9	citizen to keep and <u>to</u> bear arms, including handguns, rifles,
20	shotguns, knives, nonlethal defensive weapons, and other arms in
21	common use, as well as ammunition and the components of arms and
22	ammunition, for security, self-defense, lawful hunting and
23	recreation, in aid of the civil power when lawfully summoned or for
24	any other legitimate purpose shall never be prohibited; but nothing

1 herein contained shall prevent the Legislature from regulating the 2 carrying of weapons not be infringed. Any regulation of this right 3 shall be subject to strict scrutiny and the State of Oklahoma shall 4 be obligated to uphold these rights and shall under no circumstance 5 decline to protect against their infringement. B. This section shall not prevent the Legislature from 6 7 prohibiting the possession of arms by convicted felons, those adjudicated as mentally incompetent or those who have been 8 9 involuntarily committed in any mental institution. C. No law shall impose registration or special taxation upon 10 11 the keeping of arms, including the acquisition, ownership, 12 possession or the transfer of arms, ammunition or the components of arms or ammunition. 13 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional 14 amendment as set forth in SECTION 2 of this resolution shall be in 15 the following form: 16 BALLOT TITLE 17 Legislative Referendum No. State Question No. 18 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS: 19 This measure amends Section 26 of Article 2 of the State 20 Constitution. This section relates to the right to keep and 21 bear arms. It would state that the right to keep and bear arms 22 shall not be infringed and that the regulations by the state on 23
