

1 A. Any person entering this state in possession of a firearm
2 authorized for concealed or unconcealed carry upon the authority and
3 license of another state is authorized to continue to carry a
4 concealed or unconcealed firearm and license in this state;
5 provided, the license from the other state remains valid. The
6 firearm must either be carried unconcealed or concealed ~~from~~
7 ~~detection and view,~~ and upon coming in contact with any peace
8 officer of this state, the person must disclose the fact that he or
9 she is in possession of a concealed or unconcealed firearm pursuant
10 to a valid concealed or unconcealed carry weapons permit or license
11 issued in another state.

12 B. Any person entering this state in possession of a firearm
13 authorized for concealed carry upon the authority of a state that is
14 a nonpermitted carry state and the person is in compliance with the
15 Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, the person is authorized to carry a
16 concealed or unconcealed firearm in this state. The firearm must be
17 carried fully concealed ~~from detection and view,~~ or unconcealed and
18 upon coming in contact with any peace officer of this state, the
19 person must disclose the fact that he or she is in possession of a
20 concealed or unconcealed firearm pursuant to the nonpermitting laws
21 of the state in which he or she is a legal resident. The person
22 shall present proper identification by a valid photo ID as proof
23 that he or she is a legal resident in such a non-permitting state.
24 The Department of Public Safety shall keep a current list of non-

1 permitting states for law enforcement officers to confirm that a
2 state is nonpermitting.

3 C. Any person who is twenty-one (21) years of age or older
4 having a valid firearm license from another state may apply for a
5 handgun license in this state immediately upon establishing a
6 residence in this state.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016.
