13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.3, is
15	amended to read as follows:

17	DEFINITIONS FOR FIREARMS ACT
18	"Pistols" or "handguns" as used in the Oklahoma Firearms Act of
19	1971, Sections 1289.1 through 1289.17 of this title, shall mean any
20	firearm capable of discharging a projectile single or multiple
21	projectiles from a single round of ammunition composed of any
22	material which may reasonably be expected to be able to cause lethal
23	injury, with a barrel or barrels less than sixteen (16) inches in
24	length, and using either gunpowder, gas or any means of rocket

propulsion a combustible propellant charge, but not to include flare
guns, underwater fishing guns or blank pistols.

SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1290.2, as last amended by Section 2, Chapter 366, O.S.L. 2013 (21 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 1290.2), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1290.2.

DEFINITIONS

- A. As used in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act:
- 1. "Concealed handgun" means a loaded or unloaded pistol, the presence of which is or handgun not openly discernible visible to the ordinary observation of a reasonable person;
- 2. "Unconcealed handgun" or "open carry" means a loaded or unloaded pistol or handgun carried upon the person in a belt holster or shoulder holster that is wholly or partially where the firearm is visible, or carried upon the person in using a scabbard, sling or case designed for carrying firearms that is wholly or partially visible; and
- 3. "Pistol" or "handgun" means any derringer, revolver or semiautomatic firearm which:
 - a. has an overall <u>barrel or barrels</u> length of less than sixteen (16) inches,
 - is capable of discharging a projectile single or
 multiple projectiles from a single round of ammunition

1	composed of any material which may reasonably be
2	expected to be able to cause lethal injury,
3	c. is designed to <u>can</u> be held and fired by the use of a
4	single hand one or both hands, and
5	d. uses either gunpowder, gas or any means of rocket
6	propulsion a combustible propellant charge to
7	discharge propel the projectile or projectiles.
8	B. The definition of pistol or handgun for purposes of the
9	Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall not apply to homemade or imitation
10	pistols, flare guns, underwater fishing guns or blank pistols.
11	SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
