10 An Act relating to firearms; amending 21 O.S. 2011,
11 Section 1283, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter
12 1, O.S.L. 2019 (21 O.S. Supp. 2020, Section 1283),
13 which relates to firearm possession by convicted
14 felons and delinquents; modifying scope of certain
15 prohibited acts; removing pardon requirement for
16 persons convicted of nonviolent felonies; deleting
17 certain right; deleting handgun license revocation
18 requirement; modifying certain defined terms; and
19 providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1283, as
22 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 1, O.S.L. 2019 (21 O.S. Supp.
23 2020, Section 1283), is amended to read as follows:

24 Section 1283.

 CONVICTED FELONS AND DELINQUENTS

1 A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, it shall
2 be unlawful for any person convicted of ~~any~~ a violent felony
3 offense, or a felony offense which required the person to serve not
4 less than eighty-five (85%) of the sentence imposed by the court
5 pursuant to Section 13.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes in any
6 court of this state or of another state, a tribal court or court of
7 the United States, to have in his or her possession or under his or
8 her immediate control, ~~or in any vehicle which the person is~~
9 operating, or in which the person is riding as a passenger, or at
10 the residence where the convicted person resides, any pistol,
11 imitation or homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, machine
12 gun, sawed-off shotgun or sawed-off rifle, or any other ~~dangerous or~~
13 ~~deadly~~ firearm.

14 B. Any person who has previously been convicted of a nonviolent
15 felony in any court of this state or of another state, a tribal
16 court or court of the United States, and ~~who has received a full and~~
17 ~~complete pardon from the proper authority and has not been convicted~~
18 of any other felony or misdemeanor offense ~~which has not been~~
19 ~~pardoned~~ for a period of five (5) years, shall have restored the
20 right to possess, carry or transport any nonsemiautomatic firearm ~~or~~
21 ~~other weapon prohibited by subsection A of this section, the right~~
22 ~~to~~. The person may apply for and carry a handgun, concealed or
23 unconcealed, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense
24

1 Act or as otherwise permitted by law, and have the right to perform
2 the duties of a ~~peace officer, gunsmith, and for firearms repair.~~

3 C. It shall be unlawful for any person serving a term of
4 probation for any felony offense in any court of this state or of
5 another state, a tribal court or court of the United States, or
6 under the jurisdiction of any alternative court program to have in
7 his or her possession or under his or her immediate control, or at
8 his or her residence, or in any passenger vehicle which the person
9 is operating ~~or is riding as a passenger,~~ any pistol, shotgun or
10 rifle, including any imitation or homemade pistol, altered air or
11 toy pistol, sawed-off shotgun or sawed-off rifle, while such person
12 is subject to supervision, probation, parole or inmate status.

13 D. It shall be unlawful for any person previously adjudicated
14 as a delinquent child or a youthful offender for the commission of
15 an offense, which would have constituted a felony offense if
16 committed by an adult, to have in the possession of the person or
17 under the immediate control of the person, or have in any vehicle
18 which he or she is driving ~~or in which the person is riding as a~~
19 ~~passenger,~~ or at the residence of the person, any pistol, imitation
20 or homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, machine gun, sawed-
21 off shotgun or rifle, or any other dangerous or deadly firearm
22 within ten (10) years after such adjudication; provided, that
23 nothing in this subsection shall be construed to prohibit the
24 placement of the person in a home with a full-time duly appointed

1 peace officer who is certified by the Council on Law Enforcement
2 Education and Training (CLEET) pursuant to the provisions of Section
3 3311 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

4 E. It shall be unlawful for any person who is an alien
5 illegally or unlawfully in the United States to have in the
6 possession of the person or under the immediate control of the
7 person, or in any vehicle the person is operating, or at the
8 residence where the person resides, any pistol, imitation or
9 homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, shotgun, rifle or any
10 other dangerous or deadly firearm; provided, that nothing in this
11 subsection applies to prohibit the transport or detention of the
12 person by law enforcement officers or federal immigration
13 authorities. Any person who violates the provisions of this
14 subsection shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor
15 punishable by a fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

16 F. Any person ~~having been issued a handgun license pursuant to~~
17 ~~the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and who thereafter~~
18 knowingly or intentionally allows a convicted felon or adjudicated
19 delinquent or a youthful offender, as prohibited by the provisions
20 of subsection A, C, or D of this section, to possess or have control
21 of any ~~pistol authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act~~ firearm
22 shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine
23 not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00). ~~In addition, the~~
24 ~~person shall have the handgun license revoked by the Oklahoma State~~

1 ~~Bureau of Investigation after a hearing and determination that the~~
2 ~~person has violated the provisions of this section.~~

3 G. Any convicted or adjudicated person violating the provisions
4 of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony
5 punishable as provided in Section 1284 of this title.

6 H. For purposes of this section, ~~"sawed-off shotgun or rifle":~~

7 1. "Altered air pistol" shall mean any ~~shotgun or rifle which~~
8 ~~has been shortened to any length.~~

9 ~~I. For purposes of this section, "altered toy pistol" shall~~
10 ~~mean any toy weapon which has been altered from its original~~
11 ~~manufactured state to resemble a real weapon.~~

12 ~~J. For purposes of this section, "altered air pistol" shall~~
13 ~~mean any air pistol manufactured to propel projectiles by air~~
14 ~~pressure which has been altered from its original manufactured~~
15 ~~state.~~

16 ~~K. For purposes of this section, "alternative court program";~~

17 2. "Altered toy pistol" shall mean any toy weapon which has
18 been altered from its original manufactured state to be more
19 dangerous or powerful than the original design;

20 3. "Alternative court program" shall mean any drug court, Anna
21 McBride or mental health court, DUI court or veterans court; and

22 4. "Sawed-off shotgun or sawed-off rifle" shall mean any
23 shotgun or rifle in which the barrel or barrels have been illegally
24 shortened in length.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
