9                   A Resolution encouraging the National Rifle  
10 Association to relocate their headquarters to  
11 Oklahoma.

13                   WHEREAS, since territorial times, Oklahomans have been  
14 protective of the Second Amendment and their Constitutional right to  
15 bear arms; and

16                   WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Legislature is committed to  
17 protecting the Second Amendment rights of its citizens and  
18 supporting and passing firearm-friendly legislation including  
19 constitutional carry; and

20                   WHEREAS, the love and appreciation of firearms by Oklahomans is  
21 evident in that the state has the ninth highest firearms sales  
22 nationwide; and

1       WHEREAS, Oklahoma is open for business, allowing business owners  
2 the right to make their own decisions on how to operate, open and  
3 close their own businesses; and

4       WHEREAS, founded in 1871, the National Rifle Association, the  
5 oldest civil rights organization in the nation, finds itself looking  
6 to relocate; and

7       WHEREAS, Oklahoma, that has proven to be a state working to  
8 protect the rights of an individual to keep and bear arms, welcomes  
9 the National Rifle Association and its mission to continue educating  
10 and defending civil rights in this state for centuries to come.

11       NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES  
12 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

13       THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives encourages and  
14 welcomes the National Rifle Association to move their headquarters  
15 from Virginia to Oklahoma.

16       THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives also encourages any  
17 company that seeks freedom and liberty to locate and make its home  
18 in Oklahoma.
