are unalienable, as stated in our Declaration of Independence, and that the well-armed and well-regulated citizenry of this state, bearing all manner and quantities of arms, ammunition, and accessories, all perfectly legal under current state and federal legislation and jurisprudence, has provided a serious effective deterrent to crime, a crucial balance of power with the forces of tyranny, and a guarantee of the rights and freedom enshrined in our Constitution.

- B. The State Legislature hereby occupies and preempts the entire field of legislation by the federal government, any agency of this state or any political subdivision in this state to infringe upon the rights of a citizen of the State of Oklahoma the unalienable right to keep and bear arms as guaranteed to them by the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution.
- C. Any agency of this state or any political subdivision in this state shall be prohibited from accepting any grants or funding to implement any statute, rule or executive order, judicial order or judicial findings that would have the effect of reduction, repression, diminution or subversion of the right to keep and bear arms against or upon a citizen of this state.
- D. The provisions of this section shall not be interpreted as an attempt to overturn the provisions of the National Firearms Act of 1934 (NFA) or the provisions of the Gun Control Act of 1968, notwithstanding the repealed sections of the acts.
