10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1289.28a of Title 21, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. No person eighteen (18) years or older within this state
15 shall be denied the purchase of a firearm based on his or her age
16 unless otherwise prohibited by state law.

17 B. If a licensed dealer, as defined in Section 1289.28 of Title
18 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, submits a background check through the
19 National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) for a
20 person eighteen (18) years or older attempting to purchase a firearm
21 and receives a denial on the basis of the purchaser's age, the
22 licensed dealer shall document all evidence of such denial and
23 submit the evidence to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation
24 (OSBI).

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2024.
