



1 1. Ineligible to possess a pistol due to any felony conviction or adjudication as a delinquent as  
2 provided by Section 1283 of this title, except as provided in subsection B of Section 1283 of this  
3 title;

4 2. Any felony conviction pursuant to any law of another state, a felony conviction pursuant to  
5 any provision of the United States Code, or any conviction pursuant to the laws of any foreign  
6 country, provided such foreign conviction would constitute a felony offense in this state if the  
7 offense had been committed in this state, except as provided in subsection B of Section 1283 of this  
8 title;

9 3. Adjudication as a mentally incompetent person pursuant to the provisions of the ~~Oklahoma~~  
10 Mental Health Law, or an adjudication of incompetency entered in another state pursuant to any  
11 provision of law of that state, unless the person has been granted relief from the disqualifying  
12 disability pursuant to Section 1290.27 of this title;

13 4. Any false or misleading statement on the application for a handgun license as provided by  
14 paragraph 5 of subsection A of Section 1290.12 of this title;

15 5. Conviction of any one of the following misdemeanor offenses in this state or in any other  
16 state:

- 17 a. any assault and battery which caused serious physical injury to the victim, or
- 18 any second or subsequent assault and battery conviction,
- 19 b. any aggravated assault and battery,
- 20 c. any stalking pursuant to Section 1173 of this title, or a similar law of another
- 21 state,
- 22 d. a violation relating to the Protection from Domestic Abuse Act or any violation
- 23 of a ~~victim protection~~ protective order of another state,
- 24 e. any conviction relating to illegal drug use or possession, or

1 f. an act of domestic abuse as defined by Section 644 of this title or an act of  
2 domestic assault and battery or any comparable acts under the laws of another  
3 state.

4 The preclusive period for a misdemeanor conviction related to illegal drug use or possession  
5 shall be ten (10) years from the date of completion of a sentence. For purposes of this subsection,  
6 “date of completion of a sentence” shall mean the day an offender completes all incarceration,  
7 probation, and parole pertaining to such sentence;

8 6. An attempted suicide or other condition relating to or indicating mental instability or an  
9 unsound mind which occurred within the preceding ten-year period from the date of the application  
10 for a license to carry a concealed firearm or that occurs during the period of licensure;

11 7. Currently undergoing treatment for a mental illness, condition, or disorder. For purposes of  
12 this paragraph, “currently undergoing treatment for a mental illness, condition, or disorder” means  
13 the person has been diagnosed by a licensed physician as being afflicted with a substantial disorder  
14 of thought, mood, perception, psychological orientation, or memory that significantly impairs  
15 judgment, behavior, capacity to recognize reality, or ability to meet the ordinary demands of life;

16 8. Significant character defects of the applicant as evidenced by a criminal record indicating  
17 habitual criminal activity;

18 9. Ineligible to possess a pistol due to any provision of law of this state or the United States  
19 Code, except as provided in subsection B of Section 1283 of this title. A person who possesses a  
20 valid medical marijuana patient license shall not be considered ineligible;

21 10. Failure to pay an assessed fine or surrender the handgun license as required by a decision  
22 by the administrative hearing examiner pursuant to authority of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act;

23 11. Being subject to an outstanding felony warrant issued in this state or another state or the  
24 United States; or
