

Senate Bill 585

Sponsored by Senator BURDICK (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Repeals statute creating state preemption of local firearm regulation and statutes creating exceptions to preemption.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state preemption of firearm regulation; repealing ORS 166.170, 166.171, 166.172, 166.173,
3 166.174, 166.175 and 166.176; and prescribing an effective date.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. ORS 166.170, 166.171, 166.172, 166.173, 166.174, 166.175 and 166.176 are repealed.**

6 **SECTION 2. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021**
7 **regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
