

Senate Bill 843

Sponsored by Senator SMITH DB

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits public body from disclosing to federal governmental entity information concerning firearm transfer or concealed handgun license. Specifies exceptions.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the disclosure of information concerning firearms.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a public body may**
5 **not disclose to a federal governmental entity any information concerning:**

6 (a) **The transfer of a firearm; or**

7 (b) **An application for, or issuance, renewal, denial or revocation of, a concealed handgun**
8 **license under ORS 166.291 to 166.295.**

9 (2) **Subsection (1) of this section does not apply to:**

10 (a) **Information required to be disclosed under federal law; or**

11 (b) **Information disclosed in the process of performing a criminal background check un-**
12 **der ORS 166.256, 166.257, 166.291, 166.412, 166.434, 166.435, 166.436 or 166.540.**

13 (3) **As used in this section:**

14 (a) **“Criminal background check” has the meaning given that term in ORS 166.432.**

15 (b) **“Public body” has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.**
