AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
3 articles, providing for report of theft or loss of firearm.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

8 § 6115.1. Report of theft or loss of firearm.

9 (a) Duty to report.--An owner or other person lawfully in
10 possession of a firearm who suffers the loss or theft of a
11 firearm shall, within 72 hours of the discovery of the loss or
12 theft, report the facts and circumstances of the loss or theft
13 to the municipal police of the jurisdiction in which the loss or
14 theft is believed to have occurred or the Pennsylvania State
15 Police. The person making the report shall provide all known
16 information about the firearm, including, but not limited to,
17 the following:

- 1 (1) Name and address of the owner.
- 2 (2) All known facts and circumstances pertaining to the
3 loss or theft.
- 4 (3) Name of the manufacturer and importer.
- 5 (4) Model.
- 6 (5) Type of action.
- 7 (6) Caliber or gauge.
- 8 (7) Serial number.
- 9 (8) Any other information deemed necessary by the
10 officer or police department receiving the report.

11 (b) Sharing of information.--A law enforcement agency that
12 receives a report pursuant to this section shall, within 24
13 hours of receiving the report, forward notice of the loss or
14 theft as well as all information obtained under subsection (a)
15 to the Pennsylvania State Police.

16 (c) Pennsylvania State Police.--The Pennsylvania State
17 Police shall receive, collect and file the information forwarded
18 to it under subsection (b). The Pennsylvania State Police shall
19 cooperate and undertake to furnish or make the information
20 available to all law enforcement agencies in this Commonwealth
21 for the purpose of coordinating law enforcement efforts to
22 locate the firearm.

23 (d) Penalty.--Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a
24 person who violates subsection (a) commits:

25 (1) A summary offense for the first offense, punishable
26 by a fine not to exceed \$500.

27 (2) A misdemeanor of the second degree for a second
28 offense.

29 (3) A misdemeanor of the first degree for a third or
30 subsequent offense.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
