AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous
3 articles, further providing for firearms not to be carried
4 without a license.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 6106(b)(11) and (15) of Title 18 of the
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:

9 § 6106. Firearms not to be carried without a license.

10 * * *

11 (b) Exceptions.--The provisions of subsection (a) shall not
12 apply to:

13 * * *

14 (11) Any person while carrying a firearm in any vehicle,
15 which person possesses a valid and lawfully issued license
16 [for that] to carry a firearm which has been issued under the

1 laws of the United States or any other state.

2 * * *

3 (15) Any person who possesses a valid and lawfully
4 issued license or permit to carry a firearm which has been
5 issued under the laws of another state, regardless of whether
6 a reciprocity agreement exists between the Commonwealth and
7 the other state under section 6109(k), provided[:

8 (i) The] the other state provides a reciprocal
9 privilege for individuals licensed to carry firearms
10 under section 6109.

11 [(ii) The Attorney General has determined that the
12 firearm laws of the state are similar to the firearm laws
13 of this Commonwealth.]

14 * * *

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
