## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in offenses against public order and
- decency, providing for unlawful dissemination of residential
- 4 information.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 8 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 5518. Unlawful dissemination of residential information.
- 10 (a) Offense. -- An individual unlawfully disseminates
- 11 residential information if the individual posts signs, publishes
- 12 on a publicly accessible medium or social media site or
- 13 otherwise disseminates a visual depiction of a protected person
- 14 that the individual knows to be a protected person, the
- 15 <u>residence of a protected person, directions to a protected</u>
- 16 person's residence or messages suggesting that the protected
- 17 person has a residence in close proximity, without consent, if
- 18 such activity is <u>likely to result in the following:</u>
- 19 (1) Disclosure of the actual home, home address or the

- 1 <u>location of a protected person.</u>
- 2 (2) Actual or threatened physical harm to a protected
- 3 person or a family or household member of a protected person.
- 4 (3) Emotional distress to a protected person or a family
- 5 <u>or household member of a protected person.</u>
- 6 (b) Grading. -- A violation of subsection (a) shall
- 7 <u>constitute:</u>
- 8 (1) A misdemeanor of the third degree for a first
- 9 <u>offense.</u>
- 10 (2) A misdemeanor of the first degree for a second or
- 11 <u>subsequent offense.</u>
- (c) <u>Definitions.--As used in this section, the following</u>
- 13 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 14 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 15 "Disseminate." To cause or make an electronic or actual
- 16 <u>communication from one person, place or electronic communication</u>
- 17 device to two or more other persons, places or electronic
- 18 communication devices.
- 19 "Family or household members." The term as defined in 23
- 20 Pa.C.S. § 6102 (relating to definitions).
- 21 "Member of the armed services of the United States or
- 22 National Guard." Includes individuals on active duty and those
- 23 <u>in reserve units or guard units.</u>
- "Protected person." A public safety officer or a member of
- 25 the armed services of the United States or National Guard.
- 26 "Public safety officer." Any police officer or other officer
- 27 with the authority to make arrests for any violation of law, a
- 28 corrections officer or a probation or parole officer.
- 29 "Social media site." Any Internet-based website used by
- 30 individuals to post or share information, images or other items

- 1 with other persons.
- 2 "Visual depiction." A representation by picture, including,
- 3 <u>but not limited to, a photograph, videotape, film or computer</u>
- 4 <u>image.</u>
- 5 (d) Affirmative defense. -- The provisions of this section
- 6 shall not apply to a person engaged in, connected with or
- 7 employed by any newspaper of general circulation, any press
- 8 association, any radio or television station or any magazine of
- 9 general circulation for the purpose of gathering, procuring,
- 10 compiling, editing or publishing news.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
