AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of State Route 663 in Montgomery County as
2 the Army Specialist Ray Ira Haas Memorial Highway.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Army Specialist Ray Ira Haas Memorial Highway.

6 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
7 follows:

8 (1) On March 28, 1968, in the Quang Tri Province, South
9 Vietnam, Army Specialist Ray Ira Haas was performing his
10 assigned duty as an infantryman on the battlefield.

11 (2) During these operations, Army Specialist Haas and
12 his infantry came under fire.

13 (3) Army Specialist Haas fought bravely and was mortally
14 wounded during the firefight, later being pronounced dead at
15 a hospital in Vietnam.

16 (b) Designation.--That the portion of State Route 663 from
17 the Bucks County line, through Pennsburg Borough to the end of
18 Upper Hanover Township in Montgomery County, is hereby

1 designated the Army Specialist Ray Ira Haas Memorial Highway.

2 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
3 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
4 traffic in both directions on the highway.

5 Section 2. Effective date.

6 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
