AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, in firearms and other dangerous  
3 articles, further providing for sale or transfer of firearms.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. Section 6111 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania  
7 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding subsections to read:  
8 § 6111. Sale or transfer of firearms.

10 (c.1) Semiautomatic assault weapons.--

11 (1) No person shall sell or transfer a semiautomatic  
12 assault weapon to an individual under 21 years of age.

13 (2) No person shall sell or transfer a semiautomatic  
14 assault weapon to an individual 21 years of age or older  
15 unless the individual has completed training on the proper  
16 use and operation of a semiautomatic weapon. Proof of the  
17 completed training shall be presented at the time of sale or  
18 transfer.

1 (k) Definition.--As used in this section, the term  
2 "semiautomatic assault weapon" shall mean:

3 (1) Any of the following firearms, or copies or  
4 duplicates of the firearms in any caliber:

5 (i) All Norinco, Mitchell and Poly Technologies  
6 Avtomat Kalashnikovs models.

7 (ii) Action Arms Israeli Military Industries UZI and  
8 Galil.

9 (iii) Beretta AR70 (SC-70).

10 (iv) Colt AR-15.

11 (v) Fabrique Nationale FN/FAL, FN/LAR and FNC.

12 (vi) SWD M-10, M-II/9 and M-12.

13 (vii) Steyr AUG.

14 (viii) INTRATEC TEC-9, TEC-DC9 and TEC-22.

15 (ix) Revolving cylinder shotgun, including the  
16 Street Sweeper and Striker 12.

17 (2) A semiautomatic rifle that has an ability to accept  
18 a detachable magazine and has at least two of the following:

19 (i) A folding or telescoping stock.

20 (ii) A pistol grip that protrudes conspicuously  
21 beneath the action of the weapon.

22 (iii) A bayonet mount.

23 (iv) A flash suppressor or threaded barrel designed  
24 to accommodate a flash suppressor.

25 (v) A grenade launcher.

26 (3) A semiautomatic pistol that has an ability to accept  
27 a detachable magazine and has at least two of the following:

28 (i) An ammunition magazine that attaches to the  
29 pistol outside of the pistol grip.

30 (ii) A threaded barrel capable of accepting a barrel

1 extender, flash suppressor, forward handgrip or silencer.

2 (iii) A shroud that is attached to, or partially or  
3 completely encircles, the barrel and that permits the  
4 shooter to hold the firearm with the nontrigger hand  
5 without being burned.

6 (iv) A manufactured weight of 50 ounces or more when  
7 the pistol is unloaded.

8 (v) A semiautomatic version of an automatic firearm.

9 (4) A semiautomatic shotgun that has at least two of the  
10 following:

11 (i) A folding or telescoping stock.

12 (ii) A pistol grip that protrudes conspicuously  
13 beneath the action of the weapon.

14 (iii) A fixed magazine capacity in excess of five  
15 rounds.

16 (iv) An ability to accept a detachable magazine.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
