## A RESOLUTION

Designating June 7, 2019, as "Gun Violence Awareness Day" in 1 Pennsylvania to honor and remember all victims and survivors 2 of gun violence and declare that the Commonwealth must remain committed to reducing gun violence. 4 5 WHEREAS, Each day, 100 Americans are killed by gun violence 6 and countless others are wounded; and 7 WHEREAS, Americans are 25 times more likely to be killed with firearms than citizens in other high-income countries; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Promoting public safety in the communities they 10 serve is among a legislator's highest responsibilities; and WHEREAS, Hadiya Pendleton, a teenager who was tragically shot 11 and killed, would have celebrated her 22nd birthday on June 2, 12 13 2019; and 14 WHEREAS, To honor Hadiya and the 100 Americans whose lives 15 are cut short and the countless others who are wounded by gun violence each day, June 7, 2019, has been designated as the 16

fifth annual "National Gun Violence Awareness Day"; and

WHEREAS, The idea was inspired by a group of Hadiya's

- 1 friends, who asked their classmates to commemorate her life by
- 2 wearing orange; and
- 3 WHEREAS, They chose to wear orange because hunters wear
- 4 orange to protect themselves and others; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Orange is a color that has been embraced by the gun
- 6 safety movement because it symbolizes the value of human life;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, By wearing orange and commemorating "National Gun
- 9 Violence Awareness Day" on June 7, 2019, Americans raise
- 10 awareness about gun violence and honor the lives and lost human
- 11 potential of Americans stolen by gun violence; and
- 12 WHEREAS, The residents of this Commonwealth renew our
- 13 commitment to reduce gun violence and pledge to do all we can to
- 14 keep firearms out of the wrong hands and to encourage
- 15 responsible gun ownership to help keep our children safe;
- 16 therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate June 7,
- 18 2019, "Gun Violence Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania and
- 19 encourage the residents of this Commonwealth to support their
- 20 communities' efforts to prevent the tragic effects of gun
- 21 violence and honor and value human lives.
