A RESOLUTION

Recognizing the week of February 1 through 8, 2020, as "Gun 1 Violence Survivors Week" in Pennsylvania and recognizing Moms 2 Demand Action and other qun violence prevention organizations for their efforts in addressing gun violence and pursuit of building safer communities for the citizens of this 5 Commonwealth and country. 6 7 WHEREAS, Every year, more than 36,000 Americans are killed as a result of gun violence and 73,000 more are shot and wounded; 8 9 and WHEREAS, More than 1,600 Pennsylvanians are killed and many 10 11 more injured as a result of gun violence each year; and 12 WHEREAS, A gun violence survivor is anyone who has personally experienced gun violence, whether as a witness of an act of gun 13 14 violence, someone who was threatened or wounded with a gun or as 15 a family member or friend of someone who was wounded or killed 16 as a result of gun violence; and 17 WHEREAS, Forms of gun violence can include, but are not

limited to, gun suicides, gun homicides, domestic violence

involving a gun, shootings by law enforcement, mass shootings

- 2 WHEREAS, Fifty eight percent of American adults or someone
- 3 they care for has experienced gun violence in their lifetime,
- 4 demonstrating the reach and impact gun violence has in all
- 5 communities; and
- 6 WHEREAS, In addition to the devastating human cost, every
- 7 year gun violence costs the American economy \$229 billion; and
- 8 WHEREAS, The week of February 1 through February 8, 2020, is
- 9 a symbolic choice for "Gun Violence Survivors Week" because it
- 10 represents the time by early February when more Americans are
- 11 killed with guns than are killed in other high-income countries
- 12 in an entire year; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Moms Demand Action started as a community of moms
- 14 and dads working together to address gun violence in response to
- 15 the Sandy Hook tragedy that occurred in Connecticut on December
- 16 14, 2012; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Today, Moms Demand Action is a national network of
- 18 parents, families, students and concerned citizens dedicated to
- 19 keeping families safe, encouraging responsible gun ownership and
- 20 advocating for common-sense gun safety legislation; and
- 21 WHEREAS, Moms Demand Action, along with Mayors Against
- 22 Illegal Guns, Students Demand Action and the Everytown Survivor
- 23 Network, is part of Everytown for Gun Safety, the largest gun
- 24 violence prevention organization in the country, with nearly 6
- 25 million supporters and 350,000 donors; and
- 26 WHEREAS, Everytown for Gun Safety is joined by several other
- 27 national nonprofit organizations, including the Brady Campaign
- 28 and Giffords Law Center, in the pursuit to end gun violence in
- 29 America; and
- 30 WHEREAS, By recognizing "Gun Violence Survivors Week" the

- 2 about gun violence and honor the lives lost; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 4 week of February 1 through 8, 2020, as "Gun Violence Survivors
- 5 Week" in Pennsylvania and recognizing Moms Demand Action and
- 6 other gun violence prevention organizations for their efforts in
- 7 addressing gun violence and pursuit of building safer
- 8 communities for the citizens of this Commonwealth and country;

- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives fully acknowledge
- 11 the impact of gun violence on communities throughout this
- 12 Commonwealth and the United States; and be it further
- RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 14 strength and perseverance of survivors of gun violence.
