AN ACT

1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for persons not to
3 possess, use, manufacture, control, sell or transfer
4 firearms.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 6105(c)(8) of Title 18 of the
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended and subsection
9 (a.1) is amended by adding paragraphs to read:

10 § 6105. Persons not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell
11 or transfer firearms.

13 (a.1) Penalty.--

14 * * *

15 (6) A person who is prohibited from possessing, using,
16 controlling, selling, transferring or manufacturing a firearm
17 under subsection (c)(7) and who violates subsection (a)
18 commits a felony of the second degree.

19 (7) A person who is prohibited from possessing, using,

1 controlling, selling, transferring or manufacturing a firearm
2 under subsection (c)(8) and who violates subsection (a)
3 commits a felony of the second degree.

5 (c) Other persons.--In addition to any person who has been
6 convicted of any offense listed under subsection (b), the
7 following persons shall be subject to the prohibition of
8 subsection (a):

9 * * *

10 (8) A person who was adjudicated delinquent by a court
11 pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 6341 or under any equivalent Federal
12 statute or statute of any other state as a result of conduct
13 which if committed by an adult would constitute an offense
14 enumerated in subsection (b) with the exception of those
15 crimes set forth in paragraph (7). This prohibition shall
16 terminate 15 years after the last applicable delinquent
17 adjudication or upon the person reaching the age of 30,
18 whichever is earlier or a felony under the act of April 14,
19 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known as The Controlled Substance,
20 Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, or any equivalent Federal
21 statute or equivalent statute of any other state.

23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
