- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain provisions regarding veteran's preference
- for all veterans who are United States citizens who seek employment with the state, a
- 3 county, or a municipality.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 Section 1. That § 3-3-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 6 3-3-1. In all public departments and subdivisions and upon all public works of this state and
- 7 of the counties and municipalities of this state, any veteran, as defined in § 33A-2-1, who is a
- 8 citizen and resident of the state of the United States, shall receive preference for appointment,
- 9 employment, and promotion. Age, loss of limb, or other physical impairment which does not
- in fact incapacitate does not disqualify the veteran if the veteran possesses the qualifications and
- business capacity necessary to discharge the duties of the position involved. A veteran who has
- 12 a service-connected disability shall be given a preference over a nondisabled veteran.
