1 **An Act to provide enhanced permit criteria for current and former law enforcement**
 2 **officers.**

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 **Section 1.** That § 23-7-56 be AMENDED:

5 **23-7-56. Enhanced permit to carry concealed pistol--Renewal.**

6 A person who holds an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol may renew the
 7 permit through the sheriff of the county in which the person resides. The period for renewal
 8 begins one-hundred eighty days before the permit expires and ends thirty days after the
 9 permit expires.

10 In order to renew an enhanced permit a person shall:

- 11 (1) Pay a renewal fee in the amount of fifty dollars;
- 12 (2) Pay the fee for a fingerprint background check;
- 13 (3) Pass a fingerprint background check and a National Instant Criminal Background
 14 Check; and
- 15 (4) Present proof that ~~during~~ ;

16 (a) ~~During the period of for renewal, as~~ set forth in this section, the person:

- 17 ~~(a)~~(i) Successfully completed the live fire component of a qualifying
 18 handgun course defined in § 23-7-58;
- 19 ~~(b)~~(ii) Received instruction regarding the use of force standards; and
- 20 ~~(c)~~(iii) Received instruction regarding relevant criminal statutory changes;

21 or

22 (b) The person is a current or former law enforcement officer who, within the
 23 twelve-month period preceding the date of the expiration, qualified or
 24 requalified on a certified shooting course administered by a firearms
 25 instructor approved by the Law Enforcement Officers Standards
 26 Commission.

1 Fifty percent of the renewal fee required by this section must be retained by the
2 sheriff. The remaining fifty percent of the renewal fee required by this section must be
3 forwarded to the secretary of state for use in administering the concealed carry permitting
4 process.

5 If a person fails to renew an enhanced permit to carry a concealed pistol during
6 the period set forth in this section, the permit is deemed to be invalid. In order to obtain
7 an enhanced permit thereafter, the person shall submit an application and meet all
8 requirements set forth in § 23-7-53.
