AMEND Senate Bill No. 1637

House Bill No. 1467*

by deleting all language after the enacting clause and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-13-103, is amended by adding the following new subdivision to be designated as (b)(4) and redesignating present subdivision (b)(4) accordingly:

(4) Reckless endangerment by discharging a firearm into the air above a parade, religious service, concert, athletic event, political event, educational event, or any group of twenty-five (25) or more people who are lawfully assembled is a Class C felony. Discharging a firearm under the circumstances described in this subdivision (b)(4) shall not be an offense if the discharge of a firearm is:

(A) By a member of a law enforcement agency or any branch of the military acting in the course of the person's official duties; or

(B) The firing of non-live ammunition as part of a funeral.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to all offenses occurring on or after that date.
