WHEREAS, Dr. Clyde Lane developed vaccine and antibiotic bags used in transport from point of purchase to the farm; these bags not only provide proper storage of the medications, but they also include information to educate those who might be unfamiliar with BQA guidelines; and

WHEREAS, outside of his work with the National Cattlemen's Beef Association, Dr. Lane recently retired from the University of Tennessee as an Extension Beef Cattle Specialist, in which position he provided his leadership and experience for over thirty-seven years; and

WHEREAS, he has led numerous educational programs in his capacity as beef specialist, including the "Catch Four" Cattle handling program, Integrated Resource Management (IRM) program, Master Beef Producer program, Add-300 program, and "Back to the Basics" program; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Clyde Lane has also been active with the State youth livestock program, and he has participated in community 4-H programs related to beef; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Lane epitomizes the spirit and commitment that are characteristic of a true Tennessean; and

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly find it appropriate to pause in their deliberations to acknowledge and applaud Dr. Clyde Lane Jr. for his dedication to the State of Tennessee and the National Cattlemen's Beef Association; now, therefore,
