WHEREAS, the first elders of the congregation were Euclid Waterhouse Smartt, George Ramsey, and David Hampton Wooten; and

WHEREAS, for 125 years, the church in Viola has been a shining light to many of the residents in the surrounding valley, and its congregation is always ready to help with both the spiritual and physical needs of the community; and

WHEREAS, a powerful tool in service to the Kingdom of God, Viola church of Christ is one of the great religious institutions and catalysts for positive spiritual change in our State and nation; and

WHEREAS, Viola church of Christ has stood on the rock-solid foundation of Christian belief, service, and love for 125 years, and it is fitting for the members of this General Assembly to recognize this church at this time; now, therefore,
