SENATE BILL 1029

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, relative to alcoholic beverages.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-101(a)(14), is amended by deleting the language "one thousand (1,000)" wherever it appears and substituting instead the language "nine hundred twenty-five (925)".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-208(b)(1), is amended by deleting the language "and further, that in the official's opinion the applicant will not violate any of the provisions of this chapter;".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-602(a), is amended by deleting the language "wholesaler licensed under § 57-3-203" and substituting instead the language "wholesaler licensed under § 57-3-203 or any manufacturer licensed under § 57-3-202".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(35), is amended by deleting the language:

A restaurant within a jurisdiction that has elected Tennessee River resort district status also means a restaurant located within such district which has an indoor seating capacity of at least forty (40) and an outdoor seating capacity of at least seventy-five (75); in addition with respect to such a restaurant, the term "seasonal closing" as used in subdivision (29)(A), means the period from November 1 to March 1 or a period of time, if different from such dates, as filed by the restaurant with the alcoholic beverage commission;

and substituting instead the language:

With respect to a restaurant within a jurisdiction that has elected Tennessee River resort district status, the term "seasonal closing," as used in subdivision (29)(A), means the period from November 1 to March 1 or a period of time, if different from such dates, as filed by the restaurant with the alcoholic beverage commission;

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 7, is amended by deleting the chapter in its entirety.

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 8, is amended by deleting the chapter in its entirety.

SECTION 7. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
