AN ACT

To amend section 1115 of title 31, United States Code, to amend the description of how performance goals are achieved, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Performance Enhance-
5 ment Reform Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

2 Section 1115 of title 31, United States Code, is
3 amended—

4 (1) by amending subsection (b)(5) to read as
5 follows:

6 “(5) provide a description of how the performance
7 goals are to be achieved, including—

8 “(A) the human capital, training, data and
9 evidence, information technology, and skill sets
10 required to meet the performance goals;

11 “(B) the technology modernization investments, system upgrades, staff technology skills
12 and expertise, stakeholder input and feedback,
13 and other resources and strategies needed and
14 required to meet the performance goals;

15 “(C) clearly defined milestones;

16 “(D) an identification of the organizations, program activities, regulations, policies, operational processes, and other activities that contribute to each performance goal, both within
17 and external to the agency;

18 “(E) a description of how the agency is working with other agencies and the organizations identified in subparagraph (D) to measure
19 and achieve its performance goals as well as rel-

1 event Federal Government performance goals;
2 and

3 “(F) an identification of the agency offi-
4 cials responsible for the achievement of each
5 performance goal, who shall be known as goal
6 leaders;”; and

7 (2) by amending subsection (g) to read as fol-
8 lows:

9 “(g) PREPARATION OF PERFORMANCE PLAN.—The
10 *Chief Performance Improvement Officer of each*
11 *agency* (or the functional equivalent) shall collaborate with
12 the Chief Human Capital Officer (or the functional equiv-
13 alent), the Chief Information Officer (or the functional
14 equivalent), the Chief Data Officer (or the functional
15 equivalent), and the Chief Financial Officer (or the func-
16 tional equivalent) *of that agency* to prepare that portion
17 of the annual performance plan described under sub-
18 section (b)(5) *for that agency.*”.

19 **SEC. 3. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.**

20 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of
21 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go-Act of 2010,
22 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement
23 titled “Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation” for this
24 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record
25 by the Chairman of the *House Senate* Budget Committee,

- 1 provided that such statement has been submitted prior to
- 2 the vote on passage.

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
