Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
Section 1. Section 53A-2-501 is enacted to read:
Part 5. Firearms
53A-2-501. Educators with concealed firearm permits Request by parent to
move student.
(1) An educator, as defined in Section 53A-8a-402, who has a concealed firearm
permit issued in accordance with Section 53-5-704 or 53-5-705 and who carries or intends to
carry a concealed firearm on the grounds of the school in which the educator is employed shall:
(a) notify the principal of the school that the educator is carrying a concealed firearm;
<u>and</u>
(b) carry the firearm on the educator's person at all times when on school grounds.
(2) Upon request by a parent of a child in the educator's classroom, the principal shall
disclose to the parent that the educator has a concealed firearm permit and that the educator has
notified the principal of the educator's intent to carry the firearm while on the school grounds.
(3) If the parent requests reassignment of the parent's child from the classroom of an
educator who has notified the principal of the educator's intent to carry a concealed firearm on
school grounds, the request shall be honored.
(4) Information obtained by a parent under this section shall be kept confidential.
