2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 360

September 25, 2015 - Introduced by Representatives SANFELIPPO, ALLEN, BRANDTJEN, CRAIG, EDMING, HORLACHER, JAGLER, KLEEFISCH, KNODL, KREMER, THIESFELDT, TITTL and WEATHERSTON. Referred to Committee on Criminal Justice and Public Safety.

1 **AN ACT to create** 301.51, 941.23 (2) (f), 941.235 (2) (b) and 941.237 (3) (bm) of the
2 statutes; **relating to:** persons charged with locating persons who abscond from
3 parole, probation, and extended supervision and going armed with a firearm.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill allows a probation, extended supervision, or parole agent whose primary duty is to locate individuals who have absconded from probation, extended supervision, or parole to go armed with a concealed firearm and to go armed in a public building and on the premises of a tavern. This bill also requires the Department of Corrections to provide the person with credentials and a badge and requires the person to carry the credentials and badge while on duty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 301.51 of the statutes is created to read:
5 **301.51 Identification for persons who locate absconders.** (1) In this
6 section, "absconder agent" means a probation, extended supervision, or parole agent
7 whose primary duty is to locate individuals who have absconded from probation,
8 extended supervision, or parole.
