Wild bison licenses.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to game and fish; adjusting fees for wild
2 bison licenses; limiting the number of wild bison licenses
3 available in a lifetime; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 23-2-107(a), (e) and by creating a
9 new subsection (f) is amended to read:

10

11 **23-2-107. Wild bison licenses.**

13 (a) Except as provided in subsection (f) of this
14 section, any person who will be fourteen (14) years of age
15 or older prior to September 15 of the season for which the
16 wild bison license is issued and who qualifies under W.S.

1 23-2-106 may apply to the department for a wild bison
2 license.

4 (e) A resident applicant shall pay a license fee of
5 four hundred dollars (\$400.00) and shall pay the fee
6 required by W.S. 23-2-101(e). A nonresident applicant
7 shall pay a license fee of two thousand five hundred
8 dollars (\$2,500.00) for a license to harvest a male bison
9 or one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) for a license to
10 harvest a female bison and shall pay the fee required by
11 W.S. 23-2-101(e). The fee charged under W.S. 23-1-701
12 shall be in addition to the fee imposed under this
13 subsection.

14

15 (f) Any person who is issued a wild bison license and
16 harvests:

17

18 (i) A male of the species shall be ineligible to
19 apply for or receive a wild bison license in any future
20 year; and

21

22 (ii) A female of the species shall be ineligible
23 to apply for or receive a wild bison license in the
24 immediately following five (5) year period.
