Digital information privacy task force-reappropriation.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government and
2 privacy; specifying staffing for the digital information
3 privacy task force; designating a committee to receive task
4 force report; reappropriating money; and providing for an
5 effective date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** 2014 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 123,
10 Section 1(b) and (f) is amended to read:

12 **Section 1.**

14 (b) ~~For the 2014 interim period,~~ The task
15 force shall be staffed by the legislative service

1 office. The University of Wyoming shall serve in
2 an advisory capacity to the task force and shall
3 provide technical and other relevant information
4 as requested. State agencies shall provide
5 information and assistance to the task force as
6 requested. The task force shall hold three (3)
7 public meetings in three (3) different areas of
8 the state.

9
10 (f) The task force shall submit its
11 recommendations, including proposed legislation
12 with respect to the issues specified in
13 subsection (c) of this section, to a committee
14 designated by the management council and the
15 governor on an interim basis no later than
16 October 1, 2014 and to the joint corporations,
17 elections and political subdivisions interim
18 committee and the governor no later than October
19 1, 2015 with a final report no later than October
20 1, 2016. The first interim report due October 1,
21 2014, shall contain recommendations addressing
22 issues specified in subsection (c) of this
23 section only on a broad statewide policy level,

1 incorporating principles specified under
2 subsection (d) of this section. The October 1,
3 2014 report shall also recommend task force
4 staffing and support for the subsequent phases of
5 the study. The designated committee shall
6 consider the recommendations and develop
7 legislation it deems appropriate for
8 consideration by the legislature.

10 **Section 2.**

11
12 (a) Any unexpended, unobligated amounts remaining on
13 December 31, 2014, from the appropriation to the
14 legislative service office under 2014 Wyoming Session Laws,
15 Chapter 123, Section 1(h)(i) is reappropriated to the
16 legislative service office and shall only be used for
17 payment of salary, per diem and mileage for legislative
18 task force members to carry out the purposes of 2014
19 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 123, as amended by this act.

21 (b) Any unexpended, unobligated amounts remaining on
22 December 31, 2014, from the appropriation to the governor's
23 office under 2014 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 123,

1 Section 1(h)(ii) is reappropriated to the governor's office
2 and shall only be used for payment of authorized per diem
3 and mileage for nonlegislative task force members to carry
4 out the purposes of 2014 Wyoming Session Laws, Chapter 123,
5 as amended by this act.

6

7 (c) Notwithstanding W.S. 9-2-1008, 9-2-1012(e) and
8 9-4-207, or any other provision of law, funds
9 reappropriated in this section shall not be transferred or
10 expended for any other purpose and any unexpended,
11 unobligated funds remaining from these reappropriations
12 shall revert as provided by law on June 30, 2017.

13

14 **Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon
15 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
16 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
17 Constitution.
