3 "(f) The board of trustees in each school district may adopt
4 rules and regulations to govern employees lawfully carrying
5 concealed weapons in Wyoming under W.S. 6-8-104 on or in any
6 property or facility owned or leased by the school district. Any
7 rules and regulations adopted under this subsection shall only
8 apply to persons who are employees, as defined by subsection (g)
9 of this section. The rules under this subsection shall:

11 (i) Require any person carrying a firearm pursuant to
12 this section to maintain the firearm on his person at all times or
13 in a concealed biometric container or lock box within the direct
14 control of the individual at all times;

15
16 (ii) Establish ongoing training requirements,
17 curricula and instructor qualifications, subject to approval by
18 local law enforcement, including:

19
20 (A) An initial course of training comprised of not
21 less than sixteen (16) hours of live fire handgun training, and
22 eight (8) hours of scenario based training using nonlethal
23 training, firearms and ammunition; and

25 (B) Annual firearm qualification and documented
26 recurrent training of not less than twelve (12) hours with an
27 approved instructor.

29 (g) For purposes of subsection (f) of this section, "employee"
30 means any person employed by a school district, including but not
31 limited to, superintendents, assistant superintendents,
32 principals, assistant principals, teachers, guidance counselors,
33 librarians, teacher's aids, coaches, business managers,
34 secretaries or administrative assistants, janitors, bus drivers or
35 other employees of a school district.

37 (h) The board of trustees in any school district may waive
38 all or part of the training requirements of subsection (f)(ii) of
39 this section for isolated rural schools and employees in those
